## UERM back on top, enrolls 320 freshmen

"We're No. 1!"
This was Dean Tan-Reyes' terse message to alumni last March as she reported that two UERMMMC alumni took the 1st and 5th places of last February's physician licensure ex-



aminations in the Philippines, besting rivals from FEU, UST, UP and Fatima. She added that our 2007 graduates scored a 90% overall passing rate, "100% for first timers and 84% for retakers." Based on these, UERMMMC moved up to 2nd place in medical school board performance behind UST and ahead of FEU.


'Topnotcher Dr. Marky Jod Pandes, *cum laude* and class valedictorain, of Legazpi City received a cash gift of P100,000 from the school and various donors while fifth placer Dr. Don Leo Pepito, *cum laude* and class salutatorian, from MetroManila received a cash price of P15,000 from the school and other cash gifts from the dean and alumni president Dr. Andres Borromeo. Both served their senior internship at the UERM Hospital and are products of the PBL curriculum. Pandes plans to come to the U.S. for training then return home to be a missionary doctor in Albay. Pepito eyes a career in invasive cardiology in the U.S.

The new physicians had their oath-taking at the Manila Hotel on March 10, 2009 and were feted by the medical school at a testimonial dinner the next day at the Century Park Hotel.

# Dean bats for more scholarships

Dean Alfaretta Tan-Reyes in her report to the annual alumni foundation meeting at the Philippine Consulate yesterday, announced that the College of Medicine enrolled a bumper crop of 320 freshmen for the new school year including one *summa cum laude*, 3 *magna cum laude*, and 17 *cum laude*.

This batch also includes 26 foreign stu-

# Past and future: annual meeting highlights

Ave. Presided over by outgoing Chairman Dr. Benjamin Rigor, the body heard the somber yet cautiously optimistic report of Treasurer Dr. Elmer Gilo, the grateful words of Dean Tan-Reyes who thanked alumni for their support of various projects at the medical center, the reassuring pledge of UERMMMC Vice-Chairman Wilson Young to lead the school to financial stability and to address alumni concerns, and the reports of standing and special committees who are hard at work to improve the charitable work of alumni including the impassioned plea of AFUSA Chairman Emeritus Dr. Wilmer Heceta, one of UERMMMC's first 3 *cum laude* graduates, for

contributions to the endowment fund named in his honor as he said "Thank you for attaching my name to it!"

"Please give . . . even if only one dollar a day!"

The board also approved a budget of \$77,800 that calls for a program expenditure of \$59,000 63% of which will be for expanded scholarships, up from last year's 48%. On the revenue side, the board awaits the recommendations of an investment consultant it sought after its midyear meeting in Baltimore last March, and will consider fund raising options proposed by its ways & means committee headed by Dr. Ned Valen.

Finally, the group unanimously re-elected trustees Drs. Casibang, Dona, and Raymundo and elected new trustees

abroad and the Philippine government's new edict requiring new nurses to render long community or rural service. The dean added however that during her recruiting sorties, the foremost question of applicants from top pre-med schools is what scholarships and other financial incentives does UERM offer. She explains that St. Luke's and Fatima offer very generous financial packages immediately to top incoming freshmen. She wishes for more robust alumni scholarship or

financial aid to deserving students right from first year.

At present, the alumni foundation funds gold (\$2,000/year for four years), silver (\$1,000/year for four years), and bronze (\$500 a year) tuition scholarships, and book scholarships of \$150 a year upon recommendation of the College of Medicine's scholarship committee. A new financial aid program was also established last year by the AFUSA to address the special situations of needy students.

The school, for its part, provides entrance, university and college scholarships as well as grants-in-aid.

Other concerns of medical school applicants reported by the dean are the cost of books and living expenses. Upping up the ante on these programs, Dr. Tan-Reyes stressed, could put UERMMMC in a very formidable position to attract more high caliber applicants. In the same interview, the dean revealed that as of late January, more than 600 applicants had already been received by the college.
