

Fundraising Committee Report (FRC) of March 18, 2011 in Baltimore, Maryland

The major fundraising event of last year was the \$100-raffle during the Donor Appreciation Hour last July 1, 2010 at the Atrium of Newport Beach Marriott Hotel. Due to ongoing general economic difficulties, the result of the raffle was not as productive as anticipated. However, we were able to generate almost \$9,000 in raffle sales and netted at least \$5,000. Thank you for the extraordinary work done by Mr. Ernesto Suguitan and Mrs. Esther Querubin.

The Fundraising Committee hopes that this type of special raffle (or equivalent) will become part of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) of UERM-AFUSA as a fundraiser. It could also be incorporated in the Donor Appreciation Hour.
