Report: [Re: MarVaDC donated equipments project]
February 8, 2010 meeting with Drs. R. Divinagracia & A. Borromeo.
(Director's Office, UERMMMC Hospital)

- > 3 parts of presentation:
 - 1) Picture presentation of equipments.
 - 2) Discussed how we intend to ship the equipments, its estimated cost and accompanying papers [deed of donation, tax exemptions, value, etc]
 - 3) Process to undertake upon arrival of the shipment in Manila.

- > Donated equipments were presented / USB (memory stick) pictures taken from Dr. Sam Dona's garage. Majority of the equipments shown were contained in the table given to us by Mr. Roy Shipley [Clinical Engineering Services, JHH Ctr.]

- > They absolutely want to acquire all the equipments with the exception of the CO2 laser.

- > Dr. Divinagracia requested some few conditions:
 - 1) That all equipments must be tested & in good working condition.
 - 2) That operations & maintenance manuals should be available (or at least a copy of).
 - 3) Equipments should have at least their own power supply & cables.
He explained that they have had the difficult experience of purchasing some "peripheral accessories" of some few donated equipments in the hospital, after contacting its licensed distributors [in the Philippines] occasionally they don't get entertained by these same distributors, apparently because the equipment was not purchased from them. The same is true apparently, regarding equipment maintenance requirements.

- > Dr. Divinagracia has accepted the responsibility to be our designated consignee of our shipment, and that he will be responsible in contracting a Customs broker in handling & processing the shipment ones it arrives in the Manila port. [He did not mention any particulars regarding contact persons within the confines of the Customs Bureau]. He also gave an assurance that storage of these equipments upon arrival in UERM will not be problem.

- > Visited with friends & colleagues within the medical ctr.in some few departments of which I thought could help decide the possible placement of some of these equipments: Enthusiastically, the chairmen of Pediatrics & OB were unanimous about the radiant warmers, photo-therapy units & monitors can be placed in the Peds ICN & OB delivery rooms. Radiology dept. are interested in the ultrasound Scanner for initial diagnostics in the ER or ICU / Surgery. The fiberoptic light source can be used in the OR or in other endoscopic procedures, and so with the monitors.
- > Pictures of their dialysis machine in ICU. [to compare with what we are acquiring]
- > 2nd. Meeting with Drs. R. Divinagracia & A. Borrromeo [Feb.15] , this time with Noel Castro of Manila Forwarders. We all were briefed by Noel about how they operate with their shipping company.
Preference of unloading the shipment was discussed [North or South harbor?],
Use of a Customs Broker – also a matter of preference.
Both Drs. Were unanimous, will use UERM's own Customs broker.
Noel also explained that once the shipment has arrived unloading of the goods may need the use of a fork lift, may use their company [Manila Forwarders] or again UERM's preference. This is subject to discussion upon arrival of shipment.
The container van has a limited hours to have its contents unloaded [max.36hours].
 - there is no problem in accommodating the container van within the confines of UERM hospital during the unloading period.

At this writing, the charity department of the hospital currently operates with very few surviving equipments, prompting the Alumni Foundation to undertake this project.

The funding of the charity facility remains scarce. With this donation, the Alumni Foundation and its members understand well, that the full recovery and operations of the charity services cannot be totally restored even with this undertaking. It will however remarkably facilitate the process. The medical equipments, instruments and books will enhance significantly in the training of its interns and residents in the charity service sector.
